#### **1. FCC/TCB CHANGES**

The FCC is changing the TCB system. The 5 day grace period for uploading exhibits has been eliminated effective June 27, 2006. The TCB can only supercede an exhibit before the Certification has been granted. After the Certification has been issued the TCB can only upload additional exhibits. If it is necessary to supercede then a request must be sent to the FCC and they will decide if the exhibit can be superceded. The TCB will be able ask that a Certificate be dismissed.

Also the FCC says that you will not be able to upload files larger than a file size, 4.0Megs MAXIMUM. All files must be in either .pdf or .jpg format or the FCC will not accept them.

#### **TCB Exhibit Upload Procedure Change Notification Effective June 27, 2006**

At approximately 12:00 Noon, Eastern Time on June 27, 2006, the following changes will become effective in the TCB production processing modules:

1. The five day grace period for upload of exhibits necessary to grant an equipment authorization will be eliminated. Required exhibits must be uploaded prior to granting an authorization. A TCB may supercede any exhibit prior to grant by clicking the Supercede checkbox in the "List/Modify attachment" link. At any time the TCB can view the attachments uploaded to an application using the "Pending Application Status" link now available on the TCB e-filing page. An attachment may not be immediately viewable, since attachments must be scanned for viruses and in some instances converted to .pdf \* (*see note below*). As is now the case a TCB may upload additional exhibits to the application and may exercise the option to make an exhibit confidential up to 30 days after grant.

2. 2. After grant, the Supercede button will not be available to a TCB. The TCB will be able to upload additional attachments or can request dismissal of the application. If it is determined by the applicant or the TCB that an exhibit absolutely needs to be superceded, a TCB must request that the FCC supercede the subject exhibit. Within 30 days of grant the TCB should upload a replacement exhibit into the applicable exhibit folder, and a letter of explanation into the Cover Letters exhibit folder. The TCB should then request supercede of the original, incorrect exhibit through the [EASADMIN@fcc.gov](mailto:EASADMIN@fcc.gov) mailbox. ***If the request is approved***, the FCC will supercede the exhibit as requested and will send an e-mail to the TCB providing notification of the exhibit update. If the request is not approved, the FCC will notify the TCB via e-mail, and in that case both exhibits will be available for viewing. Supercede requests made more than 30 days after grant should continue to be filed through the [EASADMIN@fcc.gov](mailto:EASADMIN@fcc.gov) with appropriate justification. In general, it is expected that such requests will be made on rare occasions, and requests will be approved only under exceptional circumstances."
